We teach kids within a no-pressure context where they are able to enjoy learning, sharing and expressing themselves according to their abilities. The aim of our holiday camps is to teach English with an emphasis on public speaking and new vocabulary and grammar acquisition, learning and practicing the target language objectives both inside and outside the classroom while having fun!

Tuesday "The Food Factory and the Food Factory Friends" + 90 minute Cooking Workshop at 'Bread Ahead' Bakery School, Borough Market
Themes: Food, Designing and Creating Things, Meal Times, Healthy Eating

Wednesday "The Storytellers meet the Queen" + visit to Kensington Palace
Themes: Queen Victoria, How to greet a Queen, Manners and Etiquette

Thursday "Celebrity School, The Rappers and the Rhymers" language workshop + Madame Tussaud's trip
Themes: Fame, School, Reading, Language, Songs

Friday "Mr and Mrs Olympics at The Sports Palace" + tour to Arsenal Football Stadium
Themes: Sport, Games, Keeping fit and healthy, Time, Using Time
